DOG-FRIENDLY PARKS & TRAILS

Here are some great dog-friendly parks and hiking trails near the Claremont Resort & Club in Berkeley, perfect for you and your pup:

Claremont Canyon Regional Preserve

- Trails behind the resort - dogs allowed off-leash under voice control, great ridge-top views

Cesar Chavez Park

- Large grassy bay-side park with paved walking trails and off-leash dog policy under voice control

Tilden Regional Park

- Expanded trails a short drive away - many dog-friendly trails (on-leash where posted, voice-control off-leash allowed)

Ohlone Park

- A fenced dog-park along Ohlone Greenway between Hearst and MLK, divided into areas for small and large dogs. One of the oldest off-leash dog parks in the US.

Tips for you visit

- Bring water for both you and your dog; few hiking trails have faucets available.
- Check parking signs carefully around Claremont Canyon—street parking is limited and time-restricted.
- Keep dogs under voice control if off-leash and on leash in posted areas or near roads.
- Avoid the hottest midday hours for steep hikes in Claremont Canyon, as trails are exposed and can become very hot



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
