Claremont Canyon Regional Preserve

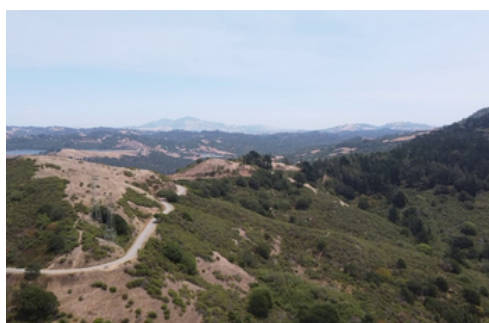

Nimitz Trail - South Trailhead

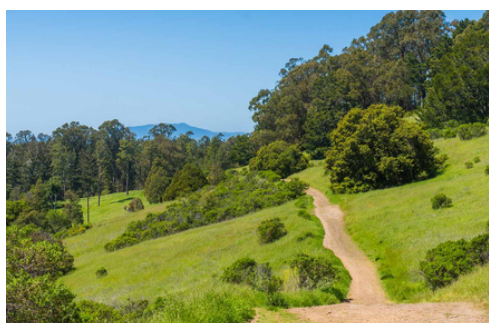
Wide, mostly paved trail with gradual elevation gain. Perfect for families, strollers, runners, and sunset walks with incredible Bay views.
